I. CALL TO ORDER

The October 17, 2024, Board Meeting was called to order at 6:05 p.m. by President, Mr. Eric Kibler.

B. Community Capital Assistance Program (CCAP) Funding Resolution #: 10-10-2024

Whereas, the Erie County Board of Developmental Disabilities applied for and was awarded \$203,280 (Two Hundred Three Thousand Two Hundred Eighty Dollars) in

Community Capital Assistance monies to purchase a property to be owned by Summit Housing Development Corporation per ORC 5123-1-03, and
